The Hôtel de Saint-Aignan

Built from 1644 to 1650 for Claude de Mesmes, Comte d'Avaux, the Hôtel de Saint-Aignan is one of the finest edifices in the Marais. Characteristic of French classical architecture in the first half of the 17th century, it was built by the architect Pierre Le Muet (1591-1669).

Paul de Beauvilliers, Duc de Saint-Aignan, bought the mansion in 1688, refurbished it and had the garden redesigned by André Le Nôtre. It was transformed into a district city hall after the Revolution, privatised in 1823 and became the home and workplace of numerous Jewish families from Central and Eastern Europe until its acquisition by Paris City Hall in 1962. The presence of these tailors, furriers, milliners, etc. is recalled by their almost effaced commercial signs in the main courtyard. Since its magnificent restoration in 1998 the Hôtel de Saint-Aignan has housed the Musée d'art et d'histoire du Judaïsme.

The musée d'art et d'histoire du Judaïsme

The museum has an exceptional collection focussing on Judaism in Europe and around the Mediterranean from Antiquity to the present day. The mahJ is one of the major cultural venues in the Marais quarter, between the Centre Pompidou and the Musée Picasso.

The museum's dynamic exhibition programme has highlighted the works of artists such as Maryan, Felix Nussbaum, Charlotte Salomon, Arnold Schönberg, Lasar Segall, Tim, Helmar Lerski and Luz, personalities such as Freud, René Goscinny, and Helena Rubinstein, and explored new themes such as the Yiddish avant-garde, Orientalism and the Jewish music scene in New York.

Formerly situated between the Duke's kitchen and dining room, between the main courtyard and the stable courtyard, this ancient vaulted hall can host meetings and training sessions with video projections, and cocktails and seated meals in an intimate setting.

The Entrance Hall

The entrance hall's original classical decoration survived alterations in the 19th century, but the main staircase was rebuilt from Pierre Le Muet's plans, published in *Manières de bastir pour toutes sortes de personnes*, and decorated with a trompe-l'œil perspective.

The entrance hall and adjacent spaces can host up to 80 people for a cocktail or breakfast.
